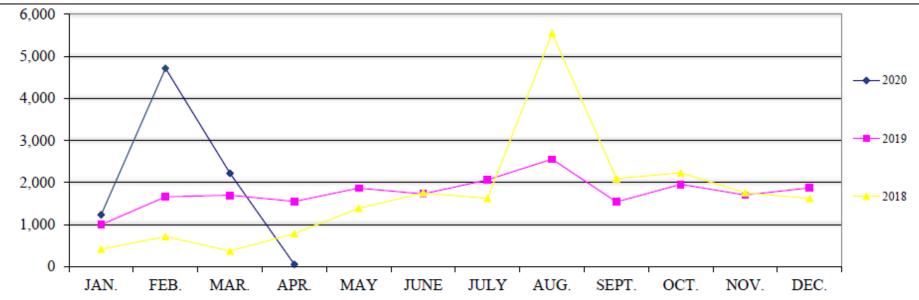












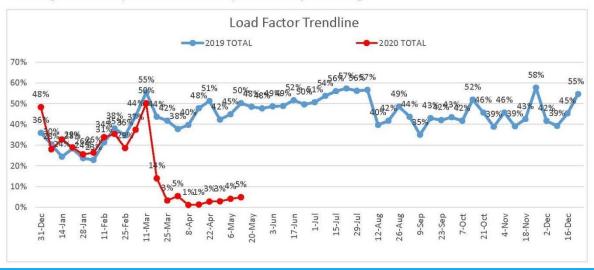
Weekly Enplanements and Load Factor

SALINA AIRPORT AUTHORITY Building 1021 Expansion Options

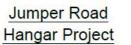


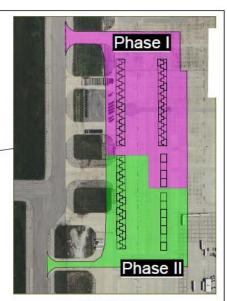

North Ramp Hangar Project



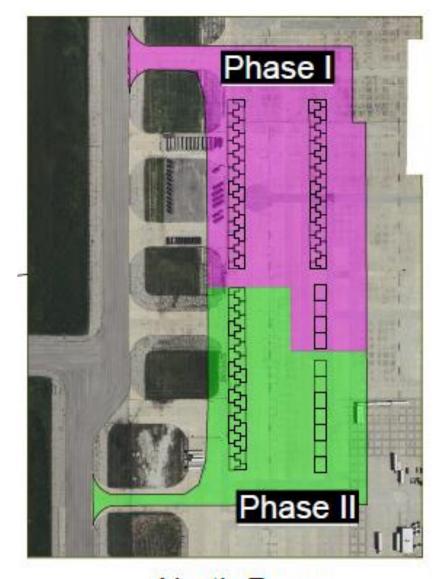
