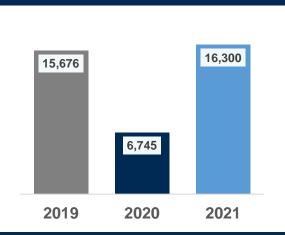


Enplanements

1) Salina <u>Outbound</u> Passenger Enplanements

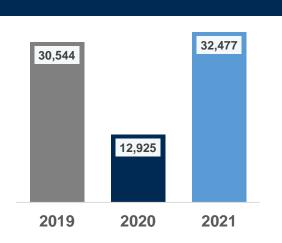
January 2019 to November 2021

January 2019 to November 2021



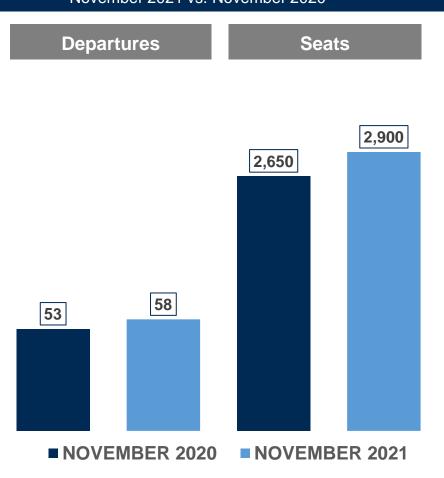


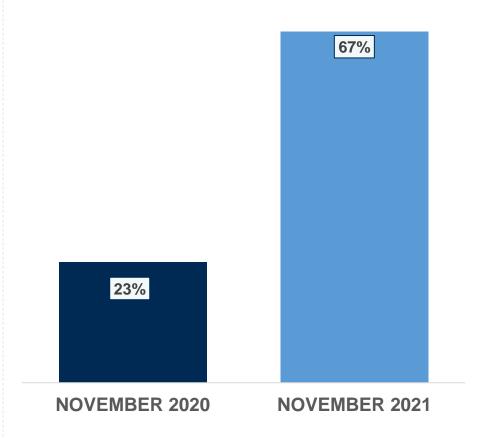

4) Salina Load FactorNovember 2021 vs. November 2020







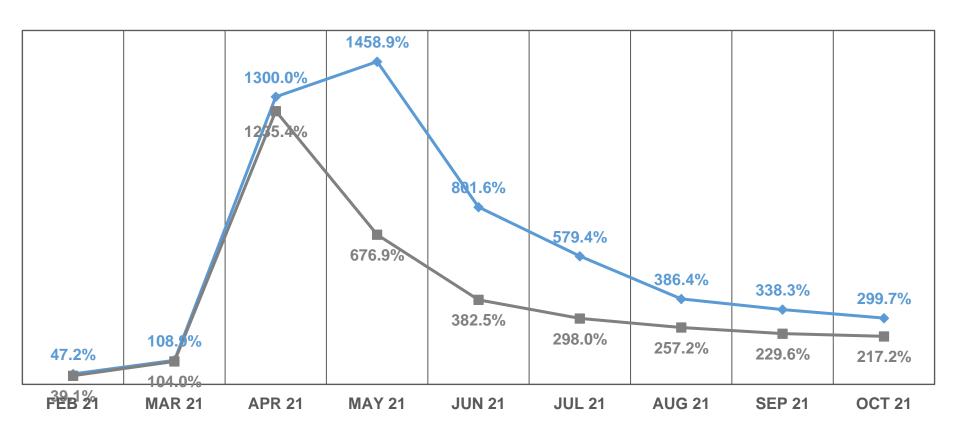
Traffic vs. Nationally

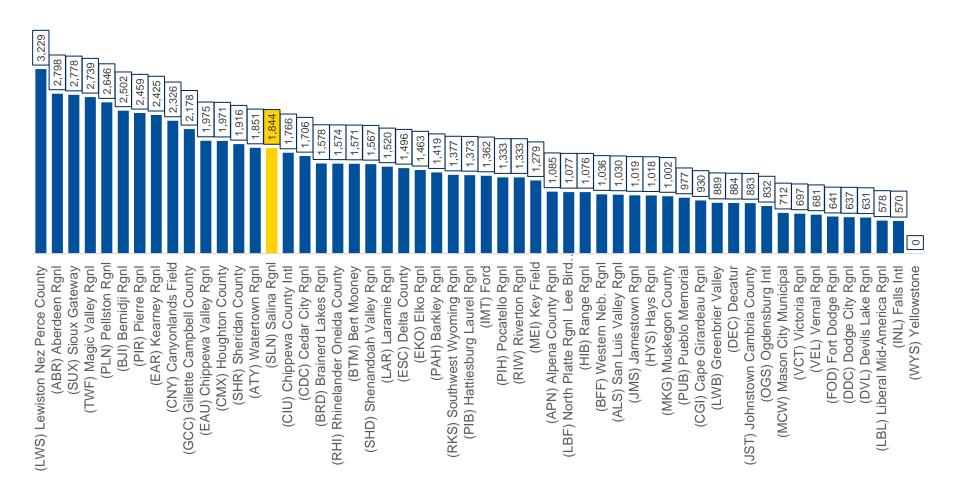

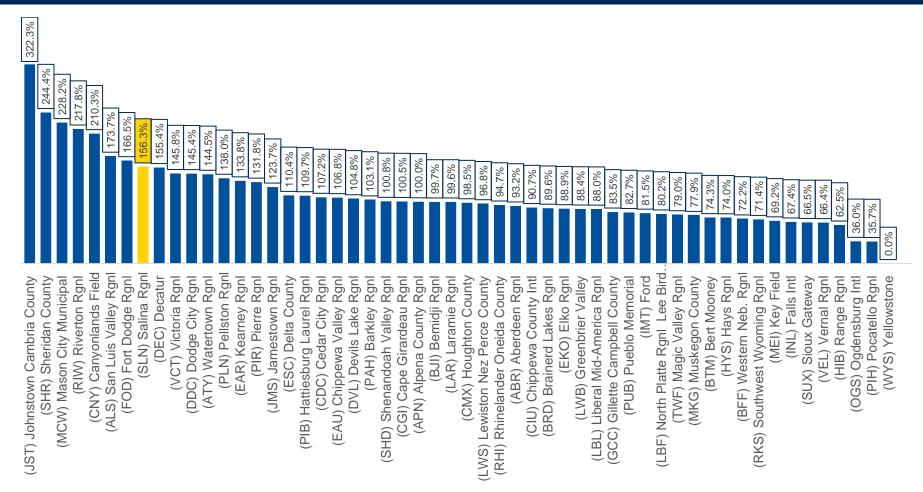

28 Days Between October 24 and November 20, 2021 vs. Same 28 Days in 2019

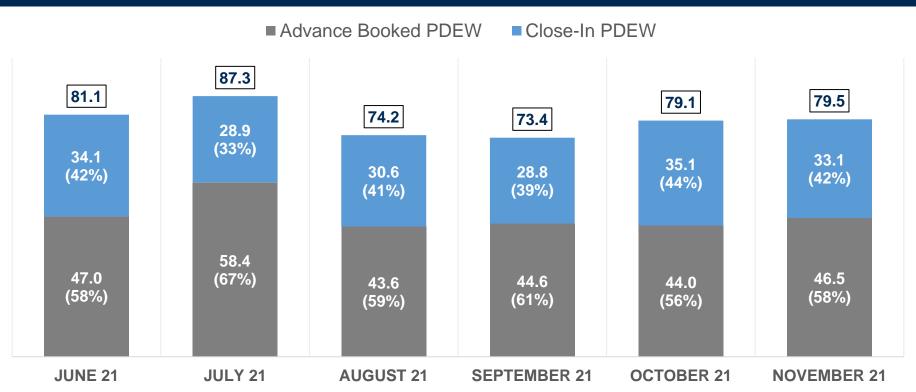


Business vs. Leisure Traffic

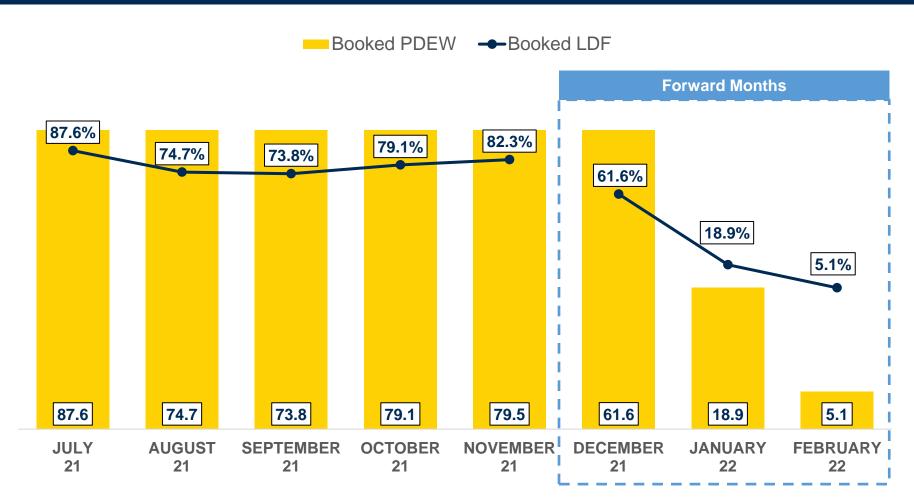

9) Booked Passengers and Load Factor at Salina, as of December 3 July 2021 to February 2022



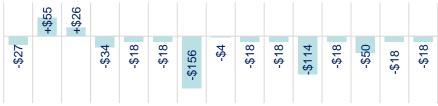

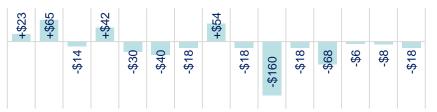

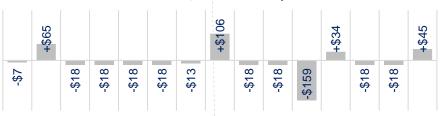

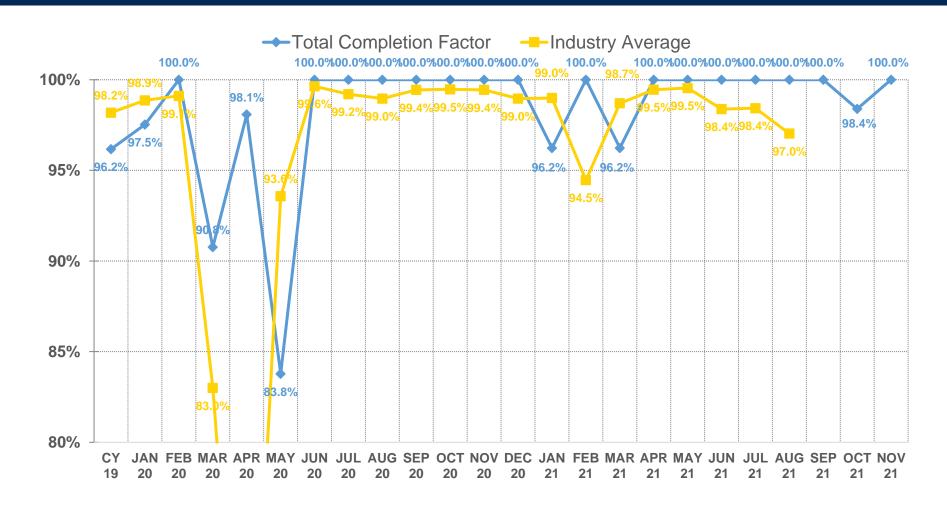

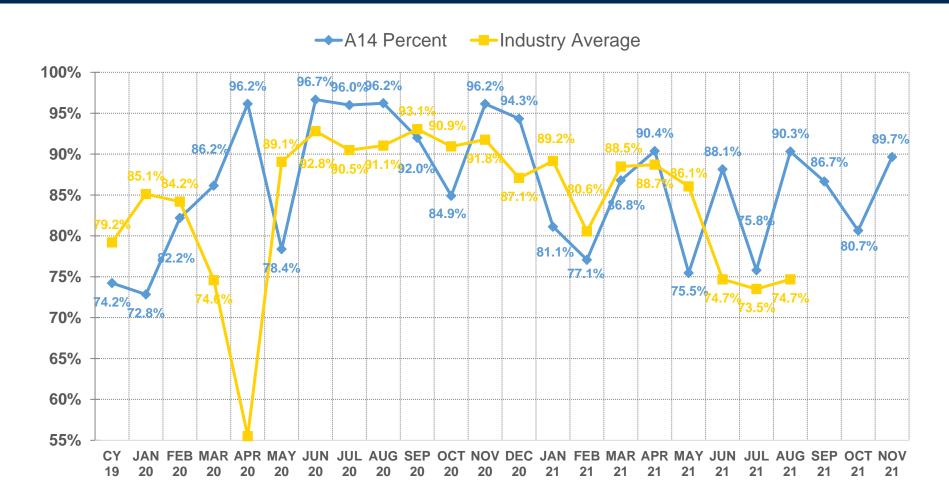
11) Total Completion Factor (Including Weather) at Salina

12) On-Time Arrivals at Salina (within 14 Minutes)

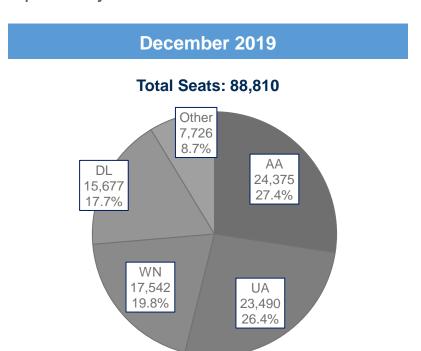

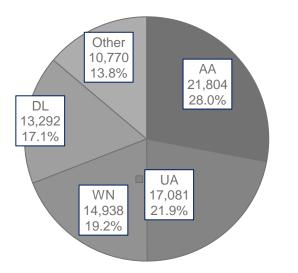
Wichita Scheduled Outbound Seat Capacity by Marketing Carrier December 2021 vs. December 2019

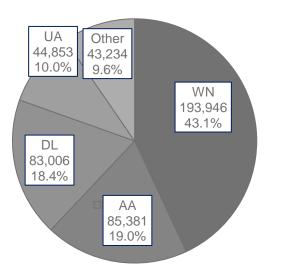
Kansas City Scheduled Outbound Seat Capacity by Marketing Carrier December 2021 vs. December 2019

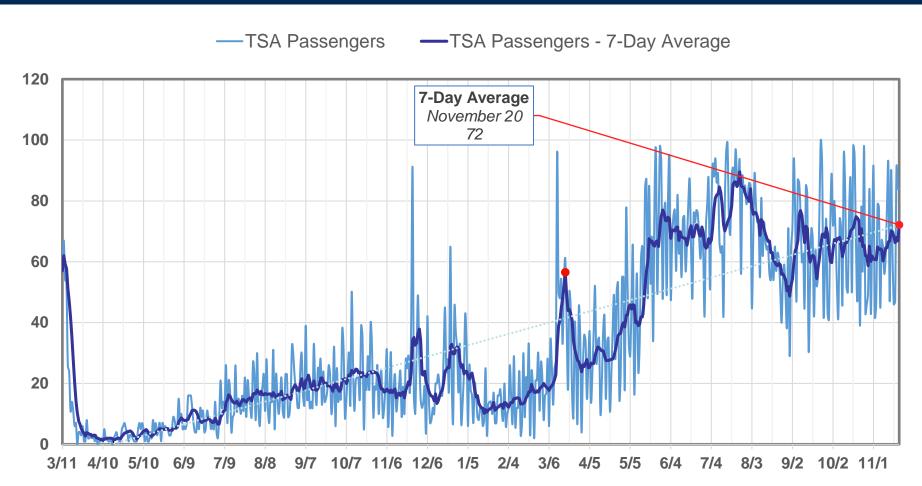

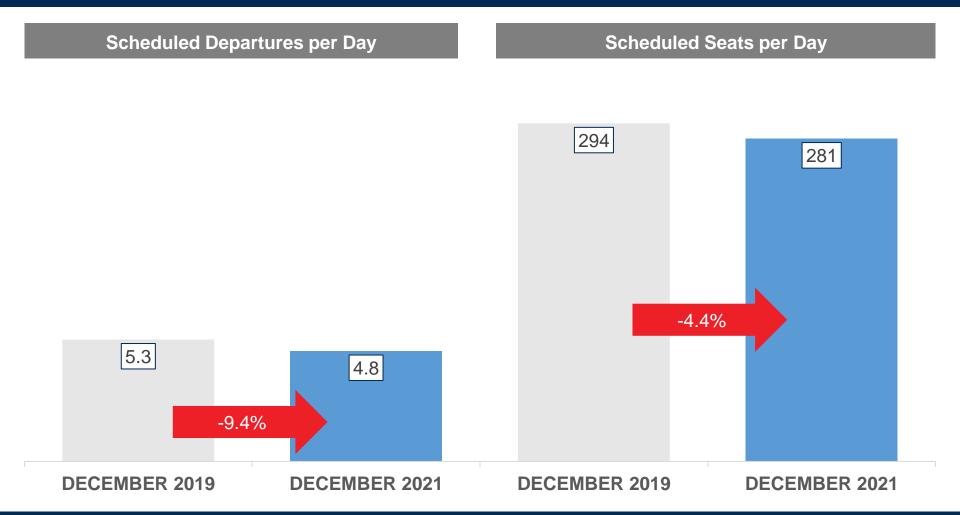

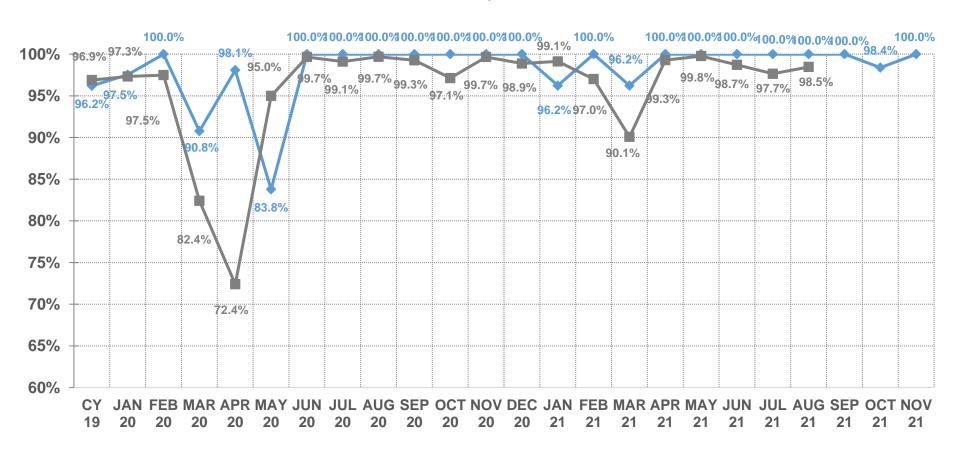

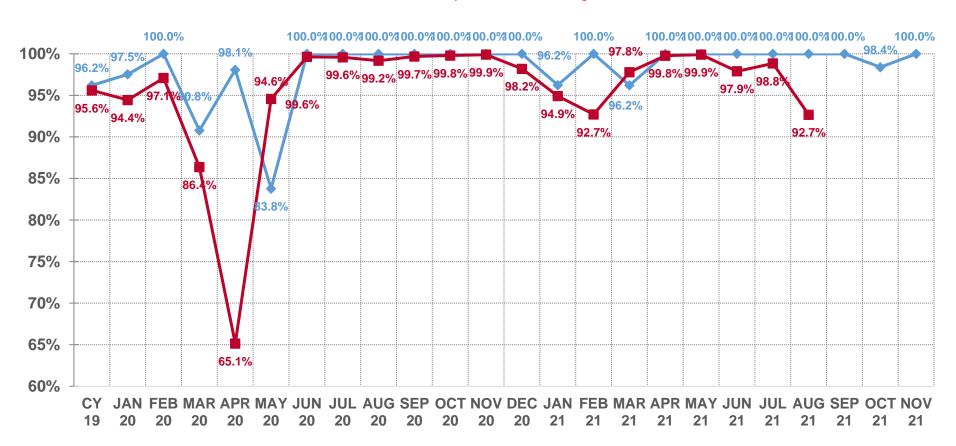

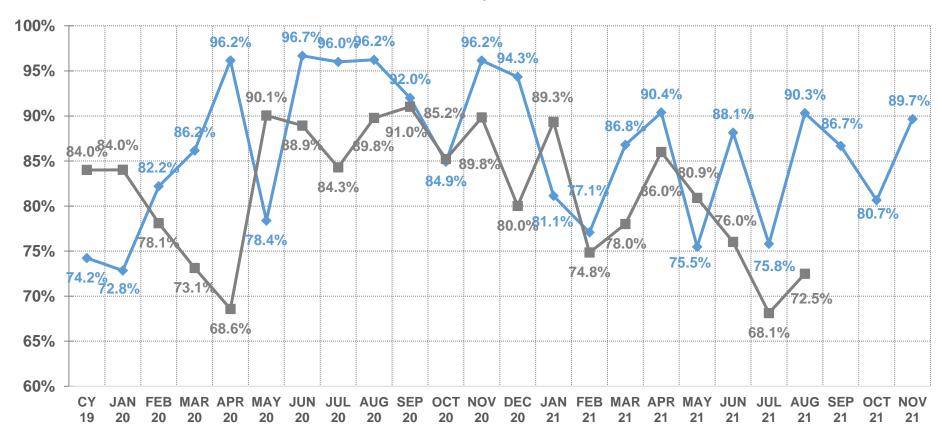

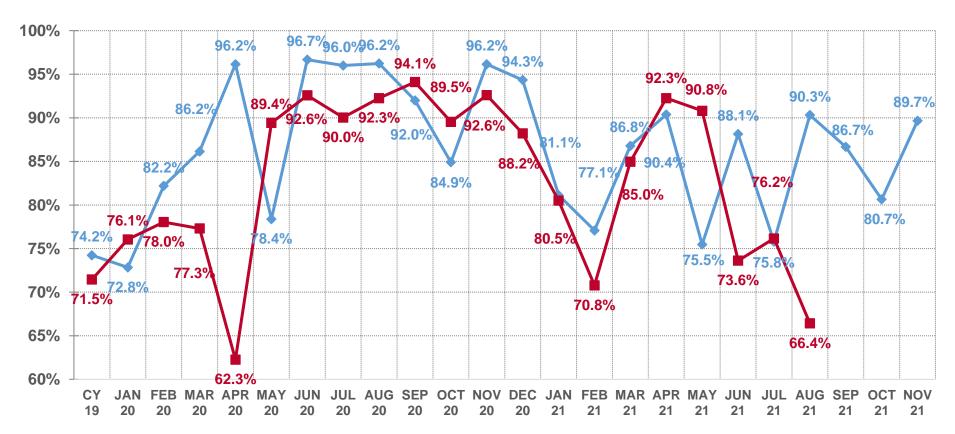

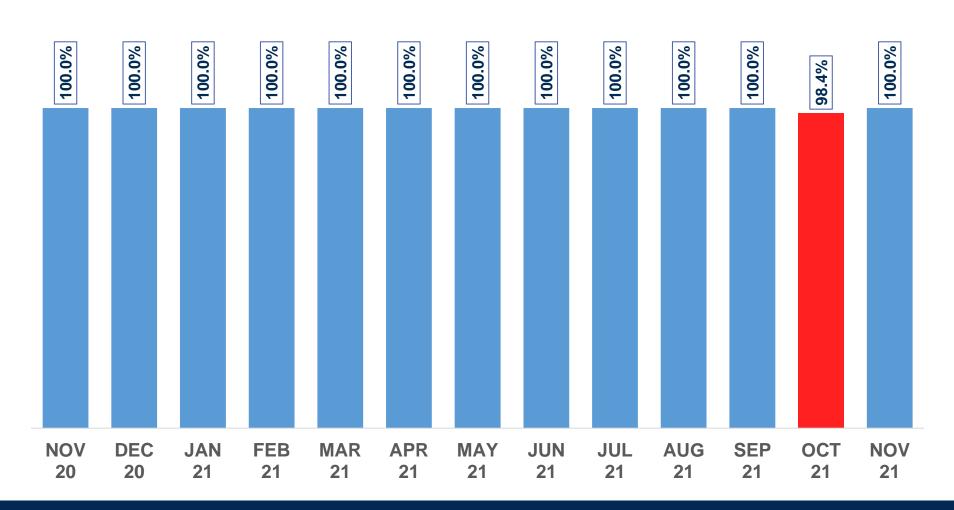

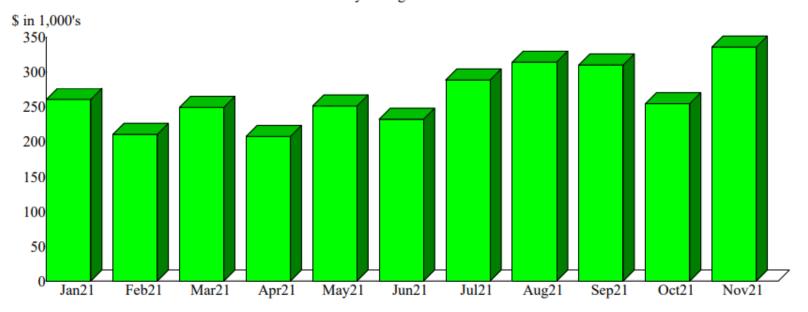
