Public Hearing

The meeting will provide SAA staff an opportunity to update SAA board members on the SAA's preliminary 2024 budget. The 2024 budget update will include an overview of the following:

- The SAA's preliminary estimates for operating revenues and expenses for calendar year 2024.
- A review of the SAA's 2024 general obligation bond debt service requirements. The SAA's 2023 mill levy requirement for calendar year 2024 G.O. bond debt service is 5.3042 mills (\$2,712,034).
- The presentation of the SAA's 2024 airport improvements budget and matching funds requirement. The SAA's 2023 mill levy requirement for funds to match federal and state grants during 2024 is 1.00 mills (\$511,303).

Following the presentation and review of the SAA's 2024 preliminary operating, G.O. bond financing and airport improvements budgets and associated 2023 mill levy requirements, a public hearing will be held to receive comments concerning the SAA's proposed 2023 mill levy. The recommended total 2023 mill levy for the SAA's 2024 budget is 6.3042 which exceeds the SAA's Revenue Neutral Rate of 4.724 mills. On July 19, 2023, the SAA notified the Saline County Clerk of an intent to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate with a proposed mill levy of 6.3042 mills.

Following the public hearing the SAA board of directors will consider Resolution No. 23-13 that declares the Salina Airport Authority's intent to levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 4.724 mills for tax tear 2023 (2024 budget year).

SALINA AIRPORT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION NO. 23-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINA AIRORT AUTHORITY, SALINA, KANSAS TO EXCEED THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE IN ITS PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE TAX YEAR OF 2023.

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for tax year 2023 for the Salina Airport Authority was calculated as 4.724 mills by the Saline County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Salina Airport Authority for budget year 2024 will require the levy of a property tax rate for tax year 2023 exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Salina Airport Authority is statutorily required to provide notice and hearing prior to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Salina Airport Authority provided notice of the August 30, 2023 hearing on the Revenue Neutral Rate on August 3, 6, and 9, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Salina Airport Authority held a hearing on August 30, 2023 allowing all interested taxpayers an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Salina Airport Authority, having heard testimony, has determined that it is in the best interests of the Salina Airport Authority to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALINA AIRPORT AUTHORITY:

The Salina Airport Authority shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 4.724 mills for Tax Year 2023.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Salina Airport Authority.
