Flower Aviation Expands Customer Service Facilities at Salina Airport

Las Vegas, NV. – Flower Aviation is increasing its presence on the Salina Municipal Airport with a new \$500,000 customer service center and a \$1.7 million hangar for overnight transient aircraft storage.

Flower Aviation and the Salina Airport Authority made the announcement jointly at the National Business Aviation Association Annual Meeting and Convention here. The Salina Airport has become “America’s Fuel Stop” for businesses jets on cross-country trips.

Todd Engel, President of Flower Aviation, said, “The customer service expansions embody the company’s commitment to quality aviation services for corporate and fractional aircraft, pilots and passengers.”

Flower Aviation of Kansas, Inc., part of the Avfuel dealer network, will soon have a modern 5,000 square foot customer terminal under a cooperative arrangement with the Salina Airport Authority.

Flower will immediately offer overnight aircraft storage in a newly refurbished 30,800 square foot hangar, capable of storing a wide range of business aircraft up to the size of a Gulfstream G550.

The expansion will better serve Flower’s substantial transient business aircraft traffic. More than 4,000 business jets refuel yearly at Flower SLN, which annually pumps over 2.5 million gallons of jet fuel. The FBO specializes in quickturns, advertising a “Spin of 10 minutes or less.”

The new customer service center will replace Flower’s existing KSLN facility that has served business aviation crews and passengers for more than 25 years. The new center will open next summer and offer a spacious customer lounge, oversized restrooms, a flight planning room and a first class catering kitchen.

The two story, 5,000 sq. ft. building will overlook KSLN's 12,300 foot primary runway 17/35 and offer waiting travelers an impressive view of one of the busiest airports in the Midwest.

Flower Aviation operates a network that includes operations in Salina, and Garden City KS, and Pueblo, CO.



The Salina Municipal Airport is the home base for seventeen aviation businesses and operations including America Jet at SLN, Aerospace Systems & Technologies, Inc., EagleMed air ambulance, Kansas Wing Headquarters – Civil Air Patrol, Flower Aviation, Kansas Army National Guard Aviation Support Facility, Kansas State University Salina College of Technology and Aviation, Kansas Highway Patrol Aviation, Professional Flight Training, LC, Raytheon Aircraft Company – Salina Division, Salina Aircraft Services and the corporate flight departments for ADM Milling Company, Blue Beacon International, Geoprobe Systems, Plains Environmental, Premier Pneumatics, Inc., and Bradley Trucking Co .

The SLN Aviation Service Center has available hangar space and room for growth to accommodate a wide array of aviation related industries. The SLN Air Traffic Control Tower logs over 85,000 annual aircraft operations. Two FBOs annually deliver over 4.4 million gallons of aviation fuel to the aircraft using the Salina Municipal Airport.
