











Frequently Asked Questions

Departing Salina

Where can I park?

Parking is **FREE** at the Salina Regional Airport. There are over 100 parking spaces within easy walking distance to the M. J. Kennedy Air Terminal building.

How do I get to the M J Kennedy Air Terminal Building?

Heading South on I135:

Take exit 89 for Schilling Rd. Turn right onto W Schilling Rd. Turn left onto S Arnold Ave.

As the Arnold Ave starts to curve into Bailey Rd. M J Kennedy Air Terminal Building will be on the right.

Heading North on I135

Take exit 89 for Schilling Rd. Turn left onto W Schilling Rd. Turn left onto S Arnold Ave.

As the Arnold Ave starts to curve into Bailey Rd. M J Kennedy Air Terminal Building will be on the right.

Is there an airport shuttle service to the M J Kennedy Air Terminal Building at the Salina Regional Airport?

Pick up at your location within the city limits of Salina Pickup can be scheduled up to 2 weeks in advance Pickup must be scheduled no later than 4:00 pm the day prior to pick-up. Cost is \$2.00 per person

Yes, the aircraft is air conditioned and pressurized.

How early should I arrive?

Plan on arriving no later than **1 hour and 30 mins** before your flight.

Is there a checked baggage fee?

There is a fee of \$25.00 for the first checked bag, \$35.00 for the second, and \$150.00 for the third.

What is the baggage weight and size for checked/carryon bags?

Overweight baggage between 51 and 70 pounds will incur an additional charge of \$100.00.

Overweight baggage between 71 and 100 pounds will incur an additional charge of \$200.00.

Active military and dependents will be allowed 3 bags measuring up to 62 inches and weighing up to 70 pounds for personal flights.

Active military and dependents will be allowed 5 bags measuring up to 115 inches and weighing up to 100 pounds for official business.

Unless on official orders, dependents must be traveling with service member to qualify for these exemptions.

Oversized bags will not be accepted.

Will my baggage get checked onto my connecting flight?

For a trip that includes one or more connections, United will check bags to the final destination stated on the ticket. United will generally transport checked baggage on the same flight as the traveler. If this is not practical, United will arrange to transport the baggage on the next flight with available space.

You'll need to claim and re-check baggage if you are:

Making a voluntary stopover

Making a connection that involves an overnight stay

Connecting to an itinerary booked on a separate ticket that doesn't include a Star Alliance partner airline

Traveling internationally and connecting to a domestic flight within your destination country













What if I am not connecting to a flight that does not have a baggage agreement with SkyWest Airlines?

CARRYON ONLY

If you are connecting to a flight with a different carrier that is not United, Delta, American or Alaska Airlines, and only have a carry-on bag, you can proceed to your connecting gate when you arrive in Denver or Chicago.

WITH CHECKED BAGS

If you have checked bags and are connecting with a different carrier that is not, United, Delta, American or Alaska Airlines, you have to leave the secure area and get collect your checked bags in the Baggage Area. You then have to check in with your connecting air carrier ticket counter and go back through the TSA security check point.

Will SkyWest Airlines provide passengers assistance when boarding at Salina and at Denver?

Yes. The Salina agents will make arrangements to assist passengers at both Salina and Denver.

Is there TSA security at the Airport?

Yes, there is TSA here at the Salina Regional Airport

Dress so you can pass through security easily. Wear slip on shoes and little or no metal. Belt buckles set off alarms.

Be ready to pass through the checkpoint, it not only helps you, but the entire line will move faster. Remember:

Laptops/iPads/Tablets or other electronic devices, must be removed from their bags and placed in a bin with nothing else.

The zip-top bag with your liquids and gels must be removed from your suitcase, purse or briefcase and placed in a bin where it is clearly visible to screeners.

Shoes, jackets and sweaters must be removed and placed in a bin. (If you are 75 years or older or 12 years and younger you do not have to remove shoes at the security checkpoint)

Minimize heavy jewelry or wearing items that could alarm at the checkpoint such as jeans with sequins or studs, shoes or boots with metal, large belt buckles, etc. When packing, visit TSA's website to learn what items are prohibited.

Is TSA Precheck available at Salina Regional Airport?

Arriving at Denver from Salina

Where do I pick up my bags when I arrive at Denver International Airport?

Baggage Claim at Denver International Airport is located in Jeppesen Terminal, on Level 5, at both the east and west sides (Terminal East and Terminal West), depending on airline. Level 5 is the same level where passengers arrive after they travel from their airline gates to Jeppesen Terminal on the automated people-mover train, which connects all concourses (A, B and C) and the terminal. After disembarking from the people-mover, passengers take escalators or elevators to Level 5 and emerge in the terminal atrium, where they will find large signs directing them to Baggage Claim. Baggage carousels are numbered and run along the east and west sides on Level 5 of Jeppesen Terminal. Carousels 1-9 are located on the east side of Jeppesen Terminal and carousels 10 - 19 can be found on the west side. Look for baggage information display monitors, which will tell you which carousel

you will find your bags. The airlines are assigned specific carousels, and their baggage claim carousels are:

United Airlines, Terminals 10-16, Terminal West

Are there other transportation services besides taxi and rental cars from **Denver International Airport?**

Denver International Airport (DEN) now has a direct rail connection from downtown to the airport. The Regional Transportation District's (RTD) University of Colorado A Line offers convenient access and reliable transportation to and from the airport and provides direct access to airline check-in, baggage check and security screening at the airport.

When you exit the aircraft, follow signs for baggage claim or the transit center. From the B and C Concourses, you must board the airport people mover tram to get to Jeppesen Terminal where baggage claim and ground transportation is located. From the A













Concourse, you may ride the tram or walk across the pedestrian bridge following the signs to the terminal.

Domestic arrivals are located in the center of the main terminal on Level 5.

International arrivals are located at the north end of the terminal. Baggage claim is also located on Level 5. To get to Denver Airport Station, follow signs to the "Transit Center" and proceed to the south end of the main terminal on Level 5 (located under the large American flag). Exit the terminal through the sliding glass doors and take the escalator located in the center of the plaza down to Level 1.

Tickets for the A Line may be purchased at the ticket vending machines located on the train platform using cash or credit cards

Arriving at Chicago O'Hare from Salina

Where do I pick up my bags when I arrive at Chicago O'Hare International Airport?

Baggage Claim at Chicago O'Hare International Airport is located on the lower level of the terminal. Look for baggage information display monitors, which will tell you which carousel you will find your bags.
